

Mixed Recycling

Combine these materials together

Plastics

Rinse containers clean of debris or residue. Include bottles and tubs 6 oz and larger, nursery pots 4" diameter or larger, and buckets up to 5-gallons.

Paper and Cardboard

Contain scrap and shredded paper in a paper bag. Include paperboard, magazines, newspaper, junk mail, milk cartons, drink boxes, soy milk, etc. Rinse beverage containers prior to setting out for recycling. Flatten boxes—size limited to < 3'x3'.

Scrap Metal, Cans and Aerosol Containers

(40 lbs. limit -30" or smaller)
Empty and rinse cans, caps, lids, aluminum foil, and foil baking trays. Remove plastic, rubber, or foreign material. Collect scrap metal pieces (lids, clips, etc.) in one can and crimp closed to prevent pieces from falling out during sorting at recovery center. Empty aerosol cans completely and discard caps. Metal paint cans will be accepted with less than 1" dry paint, remove the lid.

RECYCLE SEPARATELY ON THE SIDE

Glass

Use a bucket or rigid container to collect glass separately from other recyclables. Rinse containers and discard lids.

Motor Oil

Place motor oil in a see-through plastic 1-gallon container with a screw-top lid.

NOT ACCEPTED

- plastic bags, films, lids, spray pump tops, or chemical bottles
- soiled paper (napkins/pizza boxes), tissues, waxed paper, frozen food boxes, or hard cover books
- wax-coated cardboard
- broken glass, vases, cookware, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, or drinking glasses
- household appliances
- other liquids in containers

Yard Debris Recycling

In Washington County, yard debris collection is included with garbage service rates and is collected every-other-week on the same day garbage is collected*. To help you remember which week to set out your yard debris for collection, post this calendar and circle your yard debris and recycling collection days.

**Rural residents do not receive yard debris service as part of their rate.*

ACCEPTED

IN YARD DEBRIS CONTAINERS:

- Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Garden waste
- Prunings no greater than 4" in diameter and 36" long
- Weeds
- Branches



NOT ACCEPTED

IN YARD DEBRIS CONTAINERS:

- Plastic bags
- Garbage
- Food waste
- Plastic or wire ties
- Dirt, sod, or rock
- Garden vegetables and fruit
- Metal
- Stumps
- Animal waste
- Lumber
- Ashes



Maximum container weight:

- 100 lbs for 60-gallon container or larger
- 60 lbs for 32-gallon container
- 45 lbs for 30-gallon container
- 45 lbs for bags or bundles
