## RECYCLE AT THE CURB

### METAL & SPRAY CANS

- Empty and rinse
- Aluminum and scrap metal OK

### PAPER & CARDBOARD

- Flatten boxes
- Secure scrap paper in a paper bag

### PLASTICS

- All containers must be rinsed clean, removing all food, soil, or drink residue

**NO**  
PLASTIC BAGS  
STYROFOAM  
PAPER TOWELS  
CHEMICALS  
GARBAGE

### GLASS

- Rinse
- Place in rigid container
- No broken glass, light bulbs, vases, or drink glasses
- All colors OK

### MOTOR OIL

- Pour in sec-through plastic container with a screw-on lid
- Set next to cart

and plastic plant pots



Plastic bottles

Milk containers

Margarine, butter, cottage  
cheese and yogurt tubs

**NO**

Bags, films, zipper bags,  
or bubble wrap

Bottles used for  
hazardous products

Seedling trays or  
pots that crinkle



Toys or large  
plastic items

Lids or

less than  
6 oz

Plates, utensils, cups  
or take-out deli/  
bakery containers

Styrofoam, foam  
peanuts, blister

## OTHER RECYCLING OPTIONS

### FIND A LOCAL RECYCLING DEPOT

Many materials not accepted at the curb like electronics, appliances, batteries, tires, and other plastics can be dropped off at local depots and collection facilities.

- Put these materials INSIDE your RECYCLING ROLL CART:** (expanded list inside)
- Rigid plastics, remove food, soil, or drink residue.
  - Paper: Contain paper scraps in a paper bag. Include copy paper, newspaper, sales ads, magazines, and junk mail.
  - Cardboard: Flatten boxes—cut to less than 3'x3' and place inside cart.
  - Milk carton/drink boxes: Empty and rinse cans (labels OK). Rinse metal caps, lids, aluminum foil, and foil baking trays.
  - Scrap metal: Empty aerosol cans completely (nozzle OK). 40 lbs. limit. Pieces no longer than 36". Remove plastic, rubber, or foreign material.
  - On the side: Glass: Use red bin or rigid container to separate glass from other recyclables. Set next to roll cart. Rinse jars and bottles thoroughly, remove lids. Labels OK. No broken glass, cookware, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, or drinking glasses. Mix all colored glass together.
  - Motor oil: Place motor oil in a see-through plastic container with a screw-top lid. Set next to recyclables.
- NO PLASTIC BAGS AT THE CURB**

**EXPANDED PLASTICS**

**YES ACCEPTED - BOTTLES, TUBS, JUGS, POTS & BUCKETS**

Acceptable rigid plastics include:

- Bottles, tubs, and jugs 6 oz or larger
- Buckets 5-gallons or less (handles ok)
- Nursery plant pots 4" or larger

Rinse all clean of food, soil, or drink residue before placing in cart

**NO NOT ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING ROLL CART**

- Plastic zipper or grocery bags, film, or bubble wrap
- Blister packaging – tough, clear, molded plastic packaging
- Beverage or tub lids (they mix with paper and are disposed of at paper mills)
- Seedling trays or nursery pots that crinkle
- Disposable plates, utensils, cups, bakery/deli/take out containers
- Individual-serving containers less than 6 oz – applesauce or pudding cups
- Styrofoam trays, foam peanuts, or block Styrofoam
- Containers that held hazardous waste or chemicals

**PLASTICS NOT ACCEPTED IN CURBSIDE COLLECTION PROGRAMS MAY STILL BE RECYCLED AT LOCAL DEPOTS OR PLASTICS COLLECTION EVENTS. PLEASE SEE POSTER INSIDE FOR DETAILS.**

**GLASS ON THE SIDE!**  
Keep glass separate! Do not put glass in the roll cart. When mixed with other recycling, broken glass can cause contamination and harm workers sorting the contents. Reuse your red bins to set out glass with your roll cart recycling.

**TAKE IT AWAY!**  
Only need one bin to collect your glass? Return the second red bin to your hauler. Place it at the curb with a note requesting that your hauler take it away!
