Garbage and Recycling Collection Services and Rates for Unincorporated Washington County

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE RATES

Rates effective July 1, 2011

Standard Residential Service Charged monthly

Size of garbage can/cart	<u>Urban customers*</u> receive one cart for weekly garbage, one 96-gallon mixed recycling cart for every-other-week collection, one red bin for every-other-week glass recycling and one 60-gallon cart for every-other-week yard debris collection.	<u>Rural customers*</u> receive one cart for weekly garbage collection and two red bins for monthly recycling.
20 gallon	\$20.10	\$17.95
32 gallon	\$21.88	\$19.49
60 gallon	\$31.75	\$29.24
90 gallon	\$37.54	\$34.75
Each additional cart for recycling	\$3.00 per month	NA

Will-Call Service (Less than weekly garbage collection)

Will-Call service includes garbage collection on a per-call basis and a regular recycling collection. The recycling schedule is the same as that of the Standard or Recycling-Only Services. Will-Call is composed of two fees.	<u>Urban customers*</u> receive one 32-gallon cart for Will-Call garbage, one 96-gallon cart for every-other-week recycling and one red bin for every-other-week glass collection.	<u>Rural customers*</u> receive one cart for Will-Call garbage collection and two red bins for monthly recycling.
1. Service Fee (charged monthly)	\$9.24/month	\$10.74/month
2. Collection Fee. Charged each time the customer requests pickup of the garbage.	\$4.23/pickup	\$4.90/pickup

Residential Recycling-Only Service

<u>Urban customers*</u> receive one 96-gallon recycling cart and one red bin for glass for every-other-week recycling collection.	<u>Rural customers*</u> receive two red bins for monthly recycling collection.
\$5.00/month	\$6.58/month

**Urban* customers are located within the Metropolitan Service District Boundary
Rural customers are located outside the Metropolitan Service District Boundary

Containers and Receptacles: The hauler shall be responsible for furnishing, delivering, maintaining, and replacing all solid waste, yard debris and recycling receptacles, except a rural customer may provide the can for 32-gallon and smaller service.

Vacation Credit: A service credit will be given to customers who stop service for a period of two consecutive weeks or longer within a single calendar year period. See *Administrative Rule Section 14(H)(f)* for details on how the credit applies.
